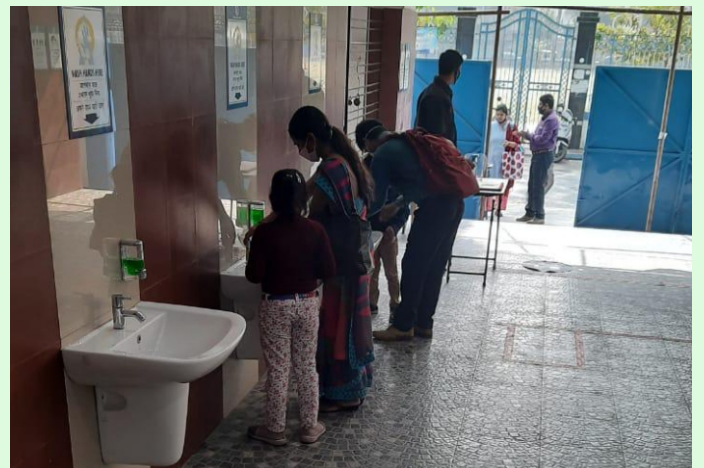

## FROM THE EDITORIALS

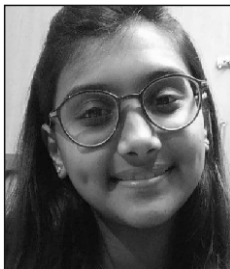

## MY EXPERIENCE WITH IAYP:



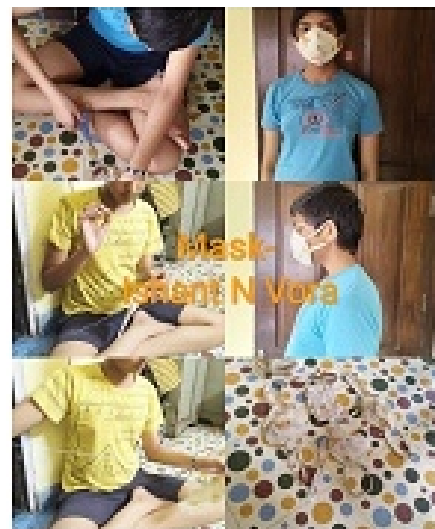

## कोविड-१९ योद्धा



कोविड-१९ महामारी ने दुनिया को तूफान सा घेर लिया है। इस महामारी के खिलाफ लड़ाई में, भारत ने २४ मार्च, २०२० को २१ दिन की तालाबंदी की घोषणा की थी। १४ अप्रैल, २०२० को लॉकडाउन की अवधि समाप्त होने के साथ ही, भारत के प्रधानमंत्री ने राष्ट्र को संबोधित किया और २१ दिनों के लॉकडाउन की घोषणा की। यह कदम वायरस के संचरण की 'शृंखला को तोड़ने' और नागरिकों के बीच सामाजिक दूरी को लागू करने के प्रयास में पेश किया गया था।

राष्ट्रव्यापी लॉकडाउन नियम के लिए दिशानिर्देश हैं कि प्रत्येक नागरिक को आपात स्थिति को छोड़कर घर पर रहना चाहिए। पूरा देश बंद हो गया है और राज्य की सीमाएं सील हैं, इसलिए केवल आवश्यक सेवाएं ही चल रही हैं। सिर्फ आवश्यक चीजों के लिए बाहर निकलने की अनुमति है, लोगों को कम से कम एक मीटर की दूरी बनाए रखने, मास्क पहनने और अल्कोहल-आधारित सैनिटाइज़र का उपयोग करने की सलाह दी जाती है। सामाजिक गड़बड़ी को सुनिश्चित करने और लागू करने के लिए, सबसे आगे के योद्धा स्थानीय पुलिस बल और केंद्रीय सशस्त्र पुलिस बल (सीएपीएफ) हैं।

अपने संबोधन के दौरान, पीएम मोदी ने देश के प्रत्येक नागरिक से कोविड-19 योद्धाओं जैसे स्वास्थ्य कार्यकर्ता, स्वच्छता कार्यकर्ता, पुलिस बल और सुरक्षा कर्मियों के लिए अपना समर्थन और सम्मान बढ़ाने का अनुरोध किया, जो इस प्रकोप के खिलाफ लड़ाई में सबसे आगे हैं। अपने घरों में फंसे नागरिकों की आत्मा को जगाने और आशा का संदेश देने के लिए, छत्तीसगढ़ के एक पुलिस अधिकारी को एक लोकप्रिय बॉलीवुड गीत का गायन करते देखा गया। यह गीत वायरस से निपटने के तरीकों का प्रस्ताव करता है और नागरिकों से वादा करता है कि वे बाहर कदम रख सकेंगे और इस महामारी के थमने के बाद दिन का उजाला देख पाएंगे। हालांकि, ऐसा करने के लिए, पहले उन्हें दूसरों की सुरक्षा को सक्षम करने के लिए घर के अंदर रहने के नियमों का पालन करना होगा। इसी तरह, कोलकाता में सेनाओं को जनता के बीच जागरूकता फैलाने के लिए प्रसिद्ध बंगाली गीतों के गायन का उपयोग करते देखा गया है। सामाजिक

कल्याण की पहल जैसे जरूरतमंदों के लिए भोजन राशन की व्यवस्था भी कई स्थानों पर पुलिस थानों के माध्यम से संभव की गई है।

पुलिस द्वारा किए गए इन नए तरीकों और तरह की पहलों ने देश भर के लोगों का बहुत ध्यान और प्रशंसा प्राप्त की है। कई भारतीयों ने बलों द्वारा इन कृत्यों के चित्रों और वीडियो के साथ-साथ दिलकश संदेश साझा करके अपनी कृतज्ञता और समर्थन के लिए सोशल मीडिया का सहारा लिया है।

मेडिकल बिरादरी के बाद सबसे कमजोर समुदाय पुलिस, प्रतिकूल परिस्थितियों में काम कर रही है। राष्ट्रपिता, महात्मा गांधी ने हमेशा पुलिस की ताकत को अहिंसक भीड़ से विशेष रूप से आंतरिक गड़बड़ी से निपटने के लिए एक अहिंसक शांति ब्रिगेड के रूप में कल्पना की थी। इस परिदृश्य में, पूरे देश ने देखा है कि उन्होंने अपने इतिहास में एक नए अध्याय को मोड़ने की कोशिश की है और गांधीजी द्वारा उनके लिए कल्पना की गई भूमिका को प्राप्त करने की दिशा में काम कर रहे हैं।

पुलिस और इसकी विकृत धारणा की त्रासदी वह है जिससे निपटना मुश्किल है। भारत में पुलिस ब्रांड को कुछ अंशांकन, कुछ आत्मनिरीक्षण, कुछ अनुशासन और दो-तरफा प्रयास की आवश्यकता है। वर्तमान स्थिति पुलिस के लिए एक मौका है और साथ ही लोगों के बल के रूप में फिर से आविष्कार करने का मौका देती है। इन विषम समयों में, खाकी न केवल कानून के कार्यान्वयन में सबसे आगे रहती है, बल्कि सामाजिक कल्याण और सामाजिक रक्षा भी करती है। देश खाकी में अपने योद्धाओं के प्रति कृतज्ञता का कर्ज चुकाता है: वे जो देश की सेवा करने के लिए चुनते हैं।

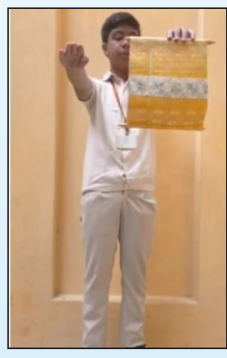
## Investiture Ceremony 2021-22
