The BGES School (ICSE) was formed in 1928 by a group of Gujarati Businessman who had migrated from Gujarat. They settled in Bhawanipur, Kolkata and adopted Kolkata as their 'Karam Bhoomi'. They felt the need to start a school to preserve and impart the Gujarati language. This led to the foundation of this esteemed institution which they called "The Bhwanipur Gujarati Education Society School". In 2018, our school completed 90 years.

We celebrated 90 years in a grand way which was a three days function held at various places.

The first function took place on 21st December, 2018 at the open amphitheatre of Kolkata – 'Uttirna'. At 1730 hours there was an Annual Function presented by the School students. It was called – '761 at the Kolkata Broadway'. The same day and at the same place at 1930 hours a second programme took place – 'Distinguished Alumni Awards'. In this programme the ex-students were felicitated who have excelled in their lives due to their immense hard work. During the celebrations, like receding hairlines, the present also receded and once again 'It was yesterday once more' for them. Their laughter, spirit of bonhomie evoked memories of my halcyon days of youth. Once again I was transported back in time when believe it or not, I was a school kid. A girl with two tightly oiled plaits, with a skirt that reached almost my ankles, who was transferred from an all girls school to a co-educational institution.

I remember most fondly the all time favourite period 'recess' and the most favourite place ( second to the library) the canteen. The chola bhatura, bun somosa, fudge and ice-cream was the menu for six days a week. Pocket money was only rupees five which increased at times, courtesy kind relatives'. Staple tiffin was paranthas, three in number (one to be consumed by yours truly and two to be shared with hostellers) either with pickle, jam, sauce or an omelette. If you thought Amma lacked imagination, believe it or not, the fare of almost all the aluminium tiffin boxes was just the same. The games played were hop scotch, pittu, blind man bluff or skipping. No cell phones or computers games!

I recall the crush we girls had on one Mr Sharp who was an Englishman and taught us Henry the VIII. The boys drooled over Mrs Jordan, whom the grapevine said had been selected Miss Delhi. The 'outstanding' girls and boys who were found perpetually punished and thrown out of the class stood happily gossiping, till the Principal Mr E.A.Tuck would come on his rounds. It was then that we had the grace to look ashamed as we were afraid of being caned in his office

MrTuck had an imported cane box which had come from all the way from England. It had five canes, of various thickness. Very politely he would ask the miscreant student which cane he would like. One apologized and went back to class. Not that one condones the system of physical punishment, but in those days the mantra that was followed at school and home was, 'Spare the rod and spoil the child.'

No photocopier machines. Everything written down by hand, to go for tuitions was a cause of embarrassment and each mother swore her children to secrecy saying that the family secret was not to be made public to anyone. However, the same master taught mathematics to almost all the students of the class. One misses laughing at inane things, crying for things that really did not matter, sharing secrets long forgotten, the class unity, the excitement of new students, vowing eternal friendship to the old.

I do miss that young girl. Where has she gone? At times, when my eyes sparkle seeing the good old fashion coming back in vogue, when I sing along with the good ole songs, when I see my students doing what we did in class, I chortle silently and the years recede. One more I am back in school.

## প্রথম যেদিন জানতে পারলাম

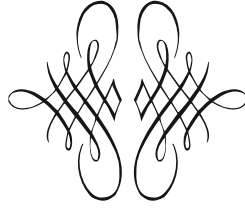

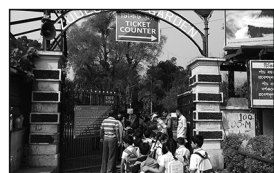
From October 2018- March 2019
