USE OF OLD TEXTBOOKS

Allotment Procedure of Science Stream for Class 9

Every year in Feb the allocation process for the Science Stream in Class 9 commences. This allocation remains provisional until the results of the Annual Examinations are announced. The allocation is based on the preferences of the students/guardians, students' performance in the first-term evaluations, and due diligence at the school.

The science stream will be allotted conditionally as stated below:-

- Students must attain a minimum of 50% marks out of 100 in each Science subject, in the first term evaluation.
- Additionally, an aggregate score of at least 55% out of 100 marks, across all subjects in the first-term evaluation is required.

If a student is allocated Science Stream but fails to meet the aforementioned criteria in the Final Evaluation, they will be shifted to the Commercial Studies stream.

Equally, if a student is not initially allocated to the Science Stream but achieves the required standards in the Final Evaluation, they will be considered for allocation to the Science Stream.

A final list will be published along with the results of the Annual Examination.
